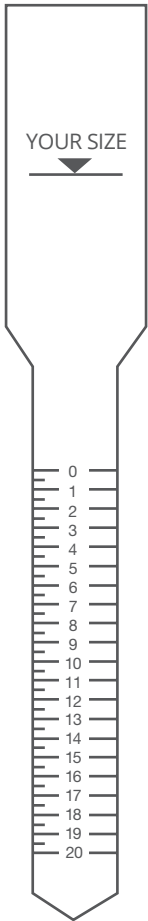


# EXCHANGE™ 2 WAYS TO FIND YOUR RING SIZE

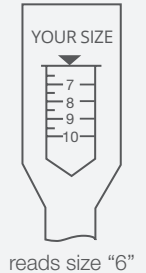
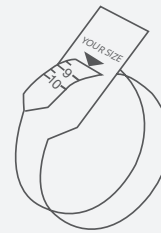
Ring Sizer



## 1

### MEASURE YOUR FINGER

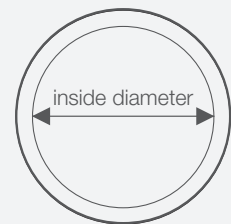
1. Print page. Make sure your printer is set to 100%, check bar below.
2. Cut out Ring Sizer to the left. Make a slit along the line marked "Your Size".
3. Wrap Ring Sizer around your finger with numbers facing out.
4. Pull the pointed end through slit until paper is snug on your finger.
5. Read finger size on scale.



## 2

### MEASURE YOUR RING

1. Print page. Make sure your printer is set to 100%, check bar below.
2. Select a ring that properly fits the finger you're shopping for.
3. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
4. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.



Measurements match the inside edge of the ring

Measure the bar to the right to make sure your printout is correctly sized. If the bar does not measure exactly 3 inches, check that page scaling is set to "none" on your print dialog box, and that you are printing at full size.
